

East Yorkshire ACCORD

Terms of Reference

The East Yorkshire ACCORD (the “**ACCORD**”) is a network of representatives from u3a groups in the the East Riding of Yorkshire listed in Schedule 1 of this Terms of Reference (the “**ACCORD u3a Groups**”).

The ACCORD shall:-

1. Meet every quarter to share information, disseminate good practise and discuss issues of concern in relation to operation of the ACCORD u3a Groups
2. Share information and experience on those speakers used by the ACCORD u3a Groups
3. Develop and maintain a policy (the “Open Door Policy”) to allow u3a members to participate in interest groups in those ACCORD u3a Groups that have themselves adopted the policy at their respective u3a group.
4. Organise shared learning, training, interest or study days to support ACCORD u3a Groups in the operation of their respective u3a groups.
5. Support communication from the Third Age Trust and the Yorkshire & Humber Region Network with the ACCORD u3a Groups

For avoidance of doubt, the ACCORD has no authority to take any action or make any decisions which are likely to impact on the operation or governance of the ACCORD u3a Groups.

Any meeting of the ACCORD shall include no more than two representatives from each of the ACCORD u3a Groups

All decisions taken by the ACCORD shall be agreed by two third majority of the ACCORD u3a Group.
