Wednesday 20 March at 10am

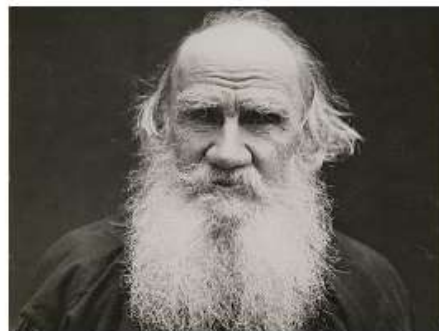
In 1850s John Snow provided evidence that cholera is a water borne disease. We'll discuss the role of John Snow and ask why he died without recognition.
